## Renewing a Spanish Driving Licence

To renew your Spanish driving licence, you will need to present the following documentation in your nearest Jefatura de Tráfico up to three months prior to the expiry date of your old licence:

1. **Application form** or “Solicitud”. The form is available in the Tráfico offices, or you may download it from the website [www.dgt.es](http://www.dgt.es). (Go to “Tu permiso de conducción – Impresos – Impresos de prórroga de la vigencia del permiso o licencia de conducción”).
2. **Proof of payment of corresponding tax**, which is currently 22.22 euros.
3. **Proof of identity and address:**
  - Spanish I.D. - original
  - **Or** Passport plus Residency Certificate for EEC citizens– original
  - **Or** Passport plus Residency for non-EEC citizens – original
4. **Medical certificate** issued by one of the medical centres authorised by your local Jefatura de Tráfico (Centro de Reconocimiento de Conductores). A photograph identical to the one presented with the “Solicitud” will need to be attached.
5. **Photograph:** One original photograph, in colour, size 32 x 26 mm, with a plain background, taken face forward, head uncovered, without sunglasses or any other article of clothing that would make identification difficult.
6. **Photo card.** This card is supplied at the Jefatura de Tráfico, and you will need to sign it.

### NOTES:

- 1) **Change of address:** If your address has changed since you last renewed your licence, then you will have to present a certificate from your Town Hall proving your current address.

2) **Payment:** The current tax to pay on this renewal is 22.50 euros.

- A) those over 70 years of age do not need to pay this tax.
- B) When, for medical reasons, the licence is to be renewed for a shorter period of time than normal, then the tax will be as follows:

Up to 4 years	17.78 euros
Up to 3 years	13.33 euros
Up to 2 years	8.89 euros
1 year, or less	4.44 euros

These prices are correct on 1<sup>st</sup> June 2010.
